



Welcome and pre-arrival information for new volunteers

Thank you so much for signing up to volunteer at Jealott's Hill Community Landshare CIC! We very much appreciate your offer of time and support.

Here's some useful information to read before you come.

What to bring/wear:

- Water bottle
- Snacks and lunch to keep you going throughout the day (we have a kitchen with basic tea, coffee, water & biscuits in return for a small donation)
- Gardening gloves – we have some 'powder free nitrile single use gloves' available and some old gardening gloves if necessary.
- Clothing that's suitable for the weather and that you don't mind getting dirty to include long trousers and long sleeves if possible. Please bring sunscreen/sunhats, rainwear/hats/warm clothing as necessary. Remember that this is not a high-fashion environment 😊
- In spring and summer, please remember to take/bring hay fever medication if you need it
- Sturdy footwear / safety boots if possible – please do not wear open-toed shoes, sandals, flipflops or crocs
- Cash in case you fancy buying some plants!
- Enthusiasm and energy!

Timings for the day:

Volunteers normally arrive at about 10am. We stop for a refreshment break mid-morning and lunch at about 1pm. The day normally finishes at about 2.30pm, but don't worry if you can't stay that long, you can leave at the right time for you.
